

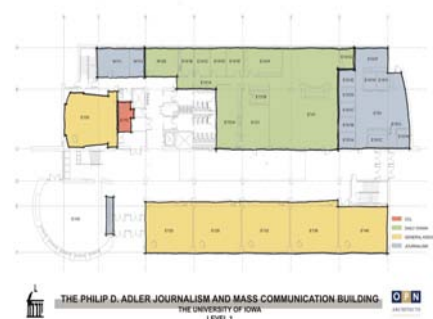
PHILIP D. ADLER JOURNALISM BUILDING



The Philip D. Adler Journalism Building and Mass Communication Building, on the University of Iowa campus, provides much needed space for the Department of Cinema and Comparative Literature, College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and the Daily Iowan newspaper.

CFA services for the project include acoustical and noise control recommendations, as well as the detailed design and commissioning of the audio-visual, sound reinforcement, instructional technology and related systems.

In addition to technologically advanced general assignment classrooms and computer labs, the Adler facility will house a cinema classroom with film and video projection capabilities, including surround sound; a broadcast classroom and studio with multiple cameras, digital video processing and switching/routing components; and a large rotunda with a 3x3 matrix videowall display system.
