

TUNICA COUNTY EXPOSITION CENTER



The Tunica County Exposition Center in Tunica County, Mississippi, is a multi-use facility which hosts equestrian events, rodeos, motor sports, and a variety of exhibits and trade shows. The facility's arena floor offers over 48 thousand square feet of exhibition space, and seats nearly 2,500 patrons. The Center also features two outdoor arenas and a 34-space RV Park.

CFA's design of a distributed sound reinforcement system includes audio feeds to the Center's arena suites, as well as outdoor riding arenas and livestock stalls. The sound reinforcement system is capable of routing audio from any of the three source locations to any or all of the public spaces.

The system was also designed with flexibility in mind, accommodating the need to host multiple events simultaneously. To provide this type of flexibility, portable equipment racks were configured with routing switches, enabling the user to send program material to specific locations "on the fly."
